**G**eraldine Mae Jaquet was born on March 10, 1923, to William and Grace (Dorman) Jaquet in Deuel County, SD. She attended Goodwin School during her youth.

Geraldine married Percy Orville Hansen on September 2, 1939, in Milbank, SD. They raised their six children on farms near Stockholm, SD, and Twin Brooks, SD. As Percy's health was failing, they sold the farm and moved to Corona.
